

## Election Petition Packets Available

The April 1, 2025 Consolidated Election will include the following Antioch Township offices:

- 1 Assessor** – 4-year term of office
- 1 Clerk** – 4-year term of office
- 1 Highway Commissioner** – 4-year term of office
- 1 Supervisor** – 4-year term of office
- 4 Township Trustees** – each for a 4-year term of office

Courtesy Election Petition Packets will be available at Antioch Township, 1275 Main Street, Antioch, IL beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 20, 2024. Or they can be obtained electronically by e-mailing [mdawe@antiochtownshipil.gov](mailto:mdawe@antiochtownshipil.gov).

**The first day to circulate** nominating petitions is Tuesday, August 20, 2024.

**The first day to file** nominating petitions at Antioch Township is on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. and **the last day to file** is Monday, November 18, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.

The Antioch Township Clerk's Office will accept petitions **Tuesday, November 12, 2024 through Friday, November 15, 2024 from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**, and on **Monday, November 18, 2024 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** during the filing period. No petitions will be accepted outside of those hours.

*Please note, anyone in line to file petitions at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday November 12, 2024 will be placed in a lottery to determine ballot placement. In order to qualify for the Simultaneous Filing Lottery on the last day of filing, you must file your petition between the hours of 4:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. on November 18, 2024.*

**No petitions will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 18, 2024.**

Due to nominating petitions being filed with the Township Clerk, she and members of the Township staff will not be able to notarize any petition documents within the packet.

It is important to note that Nominating Petition papers are subject to legal challenge by objectors if improperly completed. This information is provided as a public service. Please be advised that Antioch Township and its Clerk cannot provide a review of nominating papers or legal opinions to individuals regarding their petition papers, and make no representations regarding the accuracy or validity of these forms. Prospective candidates are strongly encouraged to consult competent legal counsel before taking action based upon these forms, and for questions related to qualifications for office, preparation of petition papers, circulator requirements, or signature requirements. Anyone who uses them does so at their own risk. Once petition papers are filed, pages cannot be amended or added. A receipt for filing the required Statement of Economic Interest may be added until 5 p.m. on the last day to file.
